- 1. Purchase of new Equipment: Discussion; a 2016 Polaris Brutus Side by Side with heat & a/c cab and loader attachment with only 102 hours and 224 miles of use has come up on an online auction. The Village has been discussing purchasing equipment that the sidewalks could be plowed with in the winter for a couple of years. The snowblower attachment will be sold separately at the sale. Public Works needs authorization and a cap on spending in order to bid on the machine. The machine can be used for many things in the Village and a sweeping attachment can be purchased in the future that is not too expensive.
- 2. Amending the Budget: Motion by Malkin to amend the Equipment Budget by \$25,000, second by Baker, All ayes, Motion carried. Giving the line item a total of \$35,250.00.
- 3. Public Works can bid up to \$25,000 on the machine & blower combined.
