The Village Council meets the Third Monday of each month at 6:30 PM. We look forward to seeing you and would like to have your input and ideas.

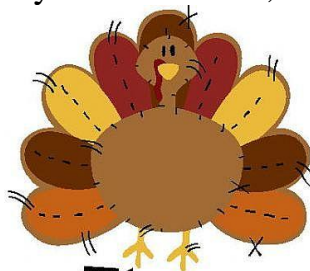
## Toy and Food Drive for Christmas
