Village Residents & Non-Residents: will pay a \$25.00 Deposit which is refundable after the park areas are cleaned up and if there is no damage to the pavilion. Non-Residents: will also be charged a \$50.00 Rental Fee

*The parks cannot be reserved by non-residents before 90 days of their event.*
