On Thursday, after noticing a box in a vacant lot on Sandy Hill Drive for two days, an Eau Claire Public Works' employee decided to pick it up. It was not an empty box as they assumed . . . it was the box I was left in. Luckily, I was found by a nice lady who contacted Paws Of Hope. Paws Of Hope made arrangements to pick me up immediately and transport me to their veterinarian for an exam. I was severely dehydrated, starving, and in pain. I received fluids and was x-rayed where it was discovered I had a broken pelvis and dislocated femur (most likely from a car hitting me). On Friday, bloodwork was done and it was found that I am a very healthy kitty and FIV/FelV negative. On Monday evening, I was rushed to a specialist in Kalamazoo where I spent the night to have surgery on Tuesday morning. My veterinarian bills are climbing and will be well over \$1,000.

EVERYONE who meets me becomes my friend. My foster family says that I am the sweetest kitty. Even though I am in extreme pain, I never lash out at those who are helping me. I only give love and gratitude to those who are caring for me.

FOSTER SUFFERED NEEDLESSLY because he was cruelly abandoned and left to die. He may have been abandoned once, but Paws Of Hope WILL NOT LET FOSTER BE ABANDONED AGAIN!
